2. Fixed Supply Charge (FSC) or Variable Supply Charge	In this Special Tariff, the Base Supply Price applies with a variance mechanism.
2.1 Variance Mechanism on the Base Supply Price	
The Variance Mechanism constitutes a parameter for determining the final supply price of the Special Tariff and is defined by law as follows: $\alpha * (DAMm-1 - Li) + b \text{ when } DAMm-1 < Li$ $0 \text{ when } Li \leq DAMm-1 \leq Lu$ $\alpha * (DAMm-1 - Lu) + b \text{ when } DAMm-1 > Lu$ where: M: The month of consumption. Correspondingly, "M-1" denotes the month immediately preceding the consumption month. a: Ο Συντελεστής Προσαύξησης, ο οποίος ισούται με 1,145. TEA M-1: The average of the Daily Day-Ahead Marketclearing Prices for the month preceding the consumption month "M", as published by the Energy Exchange. b: The b factor is calculated as the product of the fixed factor a and the difference between the Day-Ahead Market Clearing Price of the previous month (DAM-1) and the Day-Ahead Market Clearing Price of the month (DAM-2) ($b=a*(DAMm-1 - MCPm-2)$). Lu and Li: The limits of the safety range, within which the variance mechanism is not activated and, therefore, the Supply Charge is determined based on the Base Supply Price. Within the framework of specifying the above Variance Mechanism, OTE ESTATE defines a non-activation range for the variance mechanism by setting an upper limit Lu, equal to €130/MWh, and a lower limit Li, equal to €90/MWh. The Variance Mechanism is activated when DAMm-1 falls below the lower limit or exceeds the upper limit. It should be noted that the above limits, Lu and Li, remain fixed for a minimum of three (3) months, and after this period, they may be modified following a relevant announcement on the OTE ESTATE website.

Special Terms of the Contract	By signing this document, I knowledge and accept that: (1) This application simultaneously constitutes the Electricity Supply Contract with the Supplier (OTE ESTATE), unless it is formally rejected in writing by the letter. This application may not be accepted by OTE ESTATE for specific reasons, in accordance with the Electricity Supply Code to Customers (Government Gazette B' 832/2013), as amended. To be informed of the reasons why OTE ESTATE may reject this application, please contact the OTE ESTATE Customer Service Department (Customer Service Hotline: 2106377800). In case of any rejection of your application, notification will be sent to you by email within 10 days, detailing the reasons for such rejection. (2) The Electricity Supply Contract with OTE ESTATE is governed by the General Terms of the Supply Contract attached hereto and by this Application, the details of which constitute the Special Terms of the Contract. (3) I have read, understood, and fully agree with this Application and with the Special and General Terms of the Electricity Supply Contract for Household Customers (4) I am the lawful user of the installation to which the above-described supply relates. I acknowledge that I bear full responsibility for the accuracy and content of this declaration and I provide OTE ESTATE with my latest meter reading. (5) By signing this document, I expressly authorize OTE ESTATE to request from the relevant Electricity Distribution Network Operator the historical consumption data, as well as to perform any necessary actions for the representation of the meter and for the initial activation or reactivation of the connection, if required. (6) With this Application, I submit a copy of my most recent settlement bill along with the corresponding proof of payment. In the event that the most recent bill is a credit (CREDIT BILL), I also submit the previous settlement bill with the corresponding proof of payment. The personal data (hereinafter "Data"), provided by the Customer to the Supplier (OTE ESTATE) under this application for the purpose of concluding an electricity supply contract (A. CUSTOMER DETAILS: Full name, Address, Tax Identification Number (TIN), Tax Office, ID Card/Passport Number, Telephone, Mobile Phone, Email, Option to select Special Categories: Vulnerable Customers or Social Household Tariff Beneficiaries; B. BILL PAYMENT METHODS: choice of web banking, bank account, or debit/credit card; C. SUPPLY DETAILS: Property Address, Supply Number, Existing Supplier, indication if it concerns the first activation of the connection, agreed capacity, Meter Number, latest meter reading, option for activation (if required) - shall be subject to lawful processing by OTE ESTATE at any stage either prior to or following the signing of the supply contract. 3. OTE ESTATE processes the Customer's Data on the basis of one of the following lawful grounds: a) the contractual relationship or the taking of steps at the pre-contractual stage; b) the Company's legal obligations; c) the Company's legitimate interests. 4. Data Processors acting on behalf of OTE ESTATE may include authorized partners (e.g. third-party electricity suppliers, credit assessment companies, debt collection agencies), who may: a) assess the Customer's creditworthiness at the pre-contractual stage; b) manage overdue debts owed by the Customer to OTE ESTATE and contact the Customer after the expiry of the specified electricity consumption bill payment deadline, reminding them of the outstanding debt in accordance with applicable legislation; c) manage any instructions for the deactivation of the load meter (disconnection of supply) due to overdue debts owed by the Customer to OTE ESTATE, within the framework of processing the Customer's application for a change of Supplier. 6. The Customers' Data are retained for as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose for which they are processed by OTE ESTATE, unless an extension of this retention period is required due to legal claims or the Company's legal obligations. 7.
